# REVIEW REPORT ON ANNUAL FINANCIAL REPORT

To the Executive Committee of ASIA WOMEN'S LEAGUE LIMITED ("the League") (incorporated in Hong Kong with liabilities limited by guarantee)

We have audited the combined financial statements of the League for the year ended 31 March 2013 and have issued an unqualified auditors' report thereon dated 26 September 2013.

We conducted our review of the attached Annual Financial Report on pages 3 to 15 of the League for the year ended 31 March 2013 in accordance with Practice Note 851 "Review of the Annual Financial Reports of Non-governmental Organizations" issued by the Hong Kong Institute of Certified Public Accountants. The review includes considering the procedures and records relevant to the preparation of the Annual Financial Report and performing procedures to satisfy ourselves that the Annual Financial Report has been properly prepared from the books and records of the League, on which the above combined audited financial statements of the League are based.

#### Review conclusions

  - kept separate Operating Income and Expenditure Account for each subvented service unit as required by the Lump Sum Grant Manual (LSG Manual) published by the Social Welfare Department of the Government of the HKSAR;
  - 3. prepared the Annual Financial Report in accordance with the format and requirements set out in the LSG Manual; and
  - employed the staff quoted in the Provident Fund arrangements during the year ended 31 March 2013.
