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機構簡介

亞洲婦女協進會成立於 1972 年,為一所非牟利社會服務機構,以長者為主要的服務對象。本會提供優質的長者院舍照顧及社區服務,在五十多年來默默耕耘。現時亞洲婦女協進會轄下共有五個服務單位,分別有三間院舍及兩間長者活動中心。其中一間院舍和一間長者活動中心為自負盈虧性質,需外界資助而得以營運。

宗旨

本會致力促進、實施及參與長者有關的教育和社會福利活動,提供 社區為本及院舍照顧等服務,透過提供多元化服務,滿足不同長 者的需要,從而提高長者的生活質素達致豐盛晚年。本會積極發揚 「敬老、愛老、護老」的精神。轄下各服務單位均在服務上堅持實踐 會方的使命,定要做到「愛心第一、服務第一、合作第一」之工作承 諾,務求服務標準能達到相關服務之典範。

服務目標

以「非以役人,乃役於人」之精神為大眾服務以實踐「老吾老以及人之老」。

舉行第 18 屆執行委員會選舉大會及就職典禮

感謝鍾沛林律師金紫荊星章太平紳士見證下,2024年度週年會員大會暨第 18 屆執行委員會選舉大會於 2024年 10 月 31 日順利完成。亞洲婦女協進會第 18 屆執行委員會亦已於 2024年 12 月 10 日完成就職典禮。本人衷心感謝當日每一位嘉賓的到來,您們的支持與鼓勵對我們意義重大。同時,特別感謝第 17 屆執行委員會各執行委員、會長及委員在過往三年的付出及貢獻,讓本機構得以蓬勃發展。盧玉琼主席和團隊所做的努力,不僅為本會奠定了堅實的基礎,更為今屆執行委員會指引了前行的方向。

在 2024 年會員大會上通過委任鍾沛林律師金紫荊星章太平紳士及王志強律師為第 18 屆執行委員會名譽義務法律顧問。而吳愷醫生為何梁潔庭頤養之家護理院到診服務二十多年,一直盡心盡力,於新冠疫情期間亦從不間斷,讓長者得到醫治,專業精神及對長者的關愛令人敬佩,故此誠邀吳醫生擔任本會第 18 屆執行委員會名譽義務醫療顧問,持續支援本會的長者服務。

「資源效率優化計劃|下之影響

香港特別行政區政府於 2024 年 3 月公布「資源效率優化計劃」,在 2024-2025 及 2025-2026 財政年度每年節省經常開支百分之一。社會福利署為此於 2024 年 3 月 6 日出信通知本會,政府安排 2025-2026 年度及 2026-2027 年度將會削減本會整筆過撥款分別為 2% 及 3%。但隨著政府財政進一步緊縮,社會福利署於 2025 年 3 月 3 日公佈將於未來三年削減更多資助。整筆過撥款款項於 2025-2026 年度削減 2%,於 2026-2027 削減 5% 及 2027-2028 年度將削減 7%。本會面對如此大幅的削減撥款,已計劃了一系列的應對方法,並繼續以開源節流為原則,審慎理財共渡時艱。本會將繼續以量入為出的守則,維持一貫優質服務。

加強照顧者支援服務

本會自 2023 年起,將「家連家」融入服務重點,以提升對長者家屬的照顧與支援。我們將加強各單位,包括院舍及活動中心,提供更全面的心理和服務支援,促進與家屬的緊密聯繫。希望透過這些努力,讓家屬成為本會服務的重要助力,攜手為長者的福祉而共同努力。

加強本會市場推廣

本會在本年度亦增強了市場推廣,訂立了機構標誌指引,讓各單位可確保其準確且合乎規範地使 用機構標誌。在網絡及社交媒體上提升了參與度及推廣宣傳,以提高本會知名度及人脈,並進一 步開發捐款渠道。

成為《自立支援體驗日暨安老業界減約束啟動禮》的支持機構

本會一直支持援減約束,在院舍中已實行多年援減約束的多項措施。銀創基金會於2025年3月22日舉辦《自立支援體驗日暨安老業界減約束啟動禮》,邀請本會成為支持機構,實踐「自立支援」照顧模式,鼓勵減少約束,為體弱長者提升其晚年的生活質素和幸福感,達致以人為本的照顧計劃,本會當然萬分支持,亦希望藉此帶動本地業界支持減少約束。

加強業界交流

本會主席團及職員在本年度參觀多間院舍,在院舍設計及樂齡科技上有更深切的了解。本會在維持一貫良好護理質素外,將加強科技上的應用及在環境設計上提升對住客更貼心及自主的安排。

年度展望

這一年,香港社會不論在政府政策、經濟發展、資訊科技、人才流向等項目中急速變化。在這大環境底下,本會擁有專業及有魄力的團隊,勇於面對挑戰,齊心同志,預備好迎接未來的新挑戰,並把握機會迎難而上,準備好於未來一年做出更佳的服務及成績。

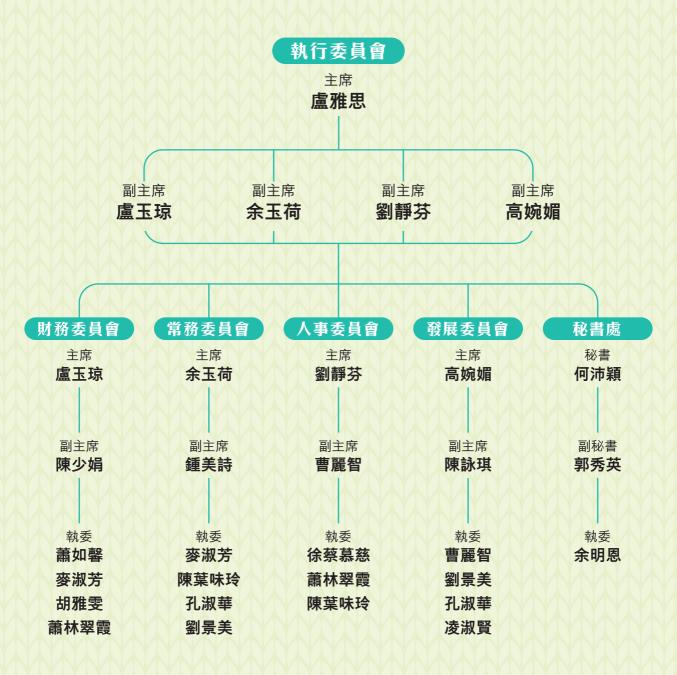

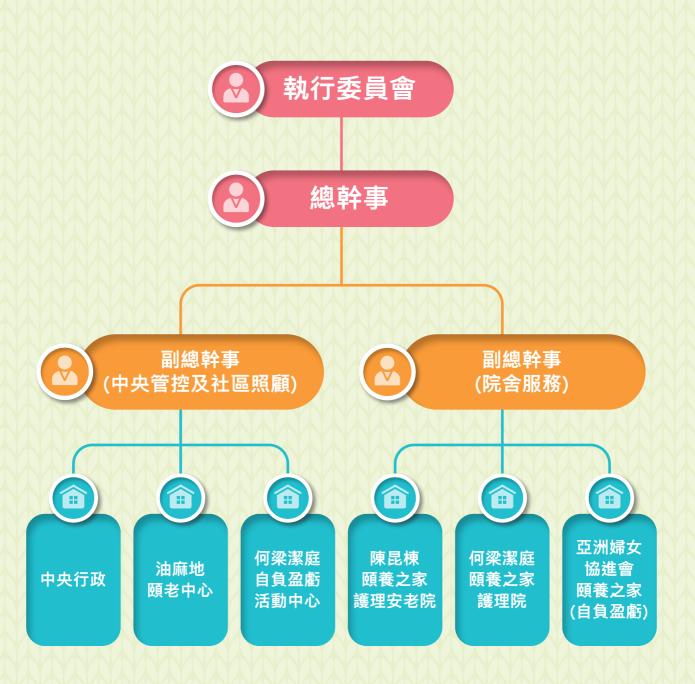

常務委員會2024/25年度報告

院舍服務

主席:余玉荷

過去一年院舍全體員工繼續致力為長者住客提供安全和舒適的生活環境,並配合本年度家連家的 主題舉辦多項活動和服務,以發展院舍住客的不同興趣及發展,鼓勵接觸新事物,為院舍生活加 添色彩。另外亦讓住客多做運動,以保持健康體魄,身心健康。

過去一年我們致力改善院舍的設施、設備和環境安全,進行了多項改善工程,以提高院舍環境及 設備質素,以確保院舍服務處於卓越水準,讓院友們得到最好的照顧和居住環境。以下是本年度 的常務工作報告:

2024-2025 年度工作報告

冠狀病毒疫苗接種計劃

為配合衛生署要求,本會分別於 2024 年 10 月及 11 月為三院多位住客,完成接種新冠疫苗加強劑,以保障院舍住客及職員的安全。

營養師到診服務

為保持住客身體健康,本會加強營養師到診服務,特別關注個別住客的營養及體重情況,為有需要的住客推行個別諮詢服務,對餐單及整體餐饍提供專業意見及分析。

改善及更新院舍設施

本會三間院舍在本年度進行了多項維修保養工程,其中主要包括:

陳昆棟頤養之家護理安老院

崇德園天花及橫陣石屎剝落維修工程、房間天花石屎維修連油漆工程、地下廚房更換銅喉工程、 更換飯堂不銹鋼餐椅、更換消防花灑入水掣不鏽鋼保護門工程。

三院維修工作

本會總部會址門口不鏽鋼車輛及客人趟閘沿用超過二十年,為確保行人及車輛出入安全,建議更換。會方以公開招標邀請承辦商參與投標,並於本年度進行開標及評分,確定承辦商作更換,工程已於年度內順利完成。

何梁潔庭頤養之家護理院及亞洲婦女協進會頤養之家牌照續期

何梁潔庭頤養之家護理院及亞洲婦女協進會頤養之家的安老院牌照於 2024 年 8 月 31 日屆滿,根據《安老院條例》第九條就安老院牌照續期,會方已提名指定負責人並已於日期屆滿前完成相關牌照續期工作。

輸入護理員宿舍和約續期

陳昆棟頤養之家護理安老院、何梁潔庭頤養之家護理院及亞洲婦女協進會頤養之家於 2022 年開始至今,申請及輸入多位護理員以補足三間護理安老院長期短缺之人手。本會在本年度,兩間現有宿舍租約續租以保持輸入護理員有固定住處,費用跟據三院輸入護理員人數分攤。

三院於年度活動

本會在本年度舉行了多個大小型康樂及社交活動給院舍住客,其中包括「老有所為」計劃,以院舍住客化身為導師教導社區人士及學生押花技巧,慶祝父親及母親節的雙親節活動,「花好月圓迎中秋暨生日會」晚宴及長者日活動、旅行、飲茶及敬老大會,為院舍住客及家屬提供多次溫馨相聚的時刻。

中心服務

油麻地頤老中心及何梁潔庭自負盈虧中心繼續為退休人士、社區長者及護老者提供服務,當中本會參與了賽馬會「與耆同絡」長者平板電腦及網上支援計劃,加強油尖旺區長者運用資訊科技和社交平台,並舉辦各項活動為社區長者及護老者減低因疫情帶來的壓力、焦慮和孤獨感,培養正面心境,以積極樂觀態度應對不同挑戰。兩間中心將繼續與服務使用者保持溝通及創新,提供溫馨和支持的環境,讓會員、地區長者及護老者感受到關愛。以下是本年度的中心服務工作報告:

大型活動

本會油麻地頤老中心及何梁潔庭自負盈虧活動中心於本年度合辦「敬雙親聯歡宴 2024」及「53 週年紀念暨敬老大會」午宴,邀請了共過千位社區長者及義工參加。「53 週年紀念暨敬老大會」當日有中心會員表演多個項目及明星唱歌,場面熱鬧。感謝多間公司、團體及本會各執行委員、會長和委員共襄善舉,認捐當日的圍席、利是、枱獎及參加者紀念品等。另外,油麻地頤老中心舉行了四次大型生日慶祝及新春團拜賀年活動。

香港賽馬會慈善信託基金資助項目

本年度油麻地頤老中心獲香港賽馬會慈善信託基金資助,推行兩個計劃,包括:賽馬會「e 健樂」電子健康管理計劃及賽馬會「與書同絡」長者平板電腦及網上支援計劃。賽馬會「e 健樂」電子健康管理計劃每季舉辦健體運動班組、八段錦運動班、平衡肌力訓練課程及長者瑜伽班為地區長者注入動力,加強長者認識保健資訊,提升自我照顧能力,令更多長者能於社區內安心居住,活得順心。賽馬會「與書同絡」長者平板電腦及網上支援計劃,此計劃為長者提供面對面支援課程、線上運動班、線上認知訓練、休閒及社交及義工訓練課程,加強長者運用電腦及網絡能力,與時並進。

財務委員會2024/25年度報告

在第 17 屆執行委員會任期中,能夠擔任執行委員會主席,是我莫大的榮幸。首先,我要衷心感謝每一位執行委員及會長的支持、信任和努力,讓我們克服了一個又一個挑戰,取得了許多可喜的成就,深刻體會到團隊合作的力量。我特別想感謝社會福利署、各政府部門及捐款善長,多年來對本會的支持。同時,我也要感謝所有合作伙伴和社會各界,正是你們的信任與支持,使我們能夠在追求卓越的道路上走得更遠。在此,更要多謝鍾沛林律師多年來鼎力支持本會及提供寶貴意見,使我們得以解決無數難題,萬分感激。

新一屆的執行委員會盧雅思主席,在她的帶領下,我深信我們的機構將會迎來更加輝煌的未來。 請大家繼續支持我們,延續我們共同的使命與願景。財務委員會承蒙各位執行委員、會長和全體 職員協助,讓我們過去一年工作得以順利完成,現將工作狀況簡報如下:

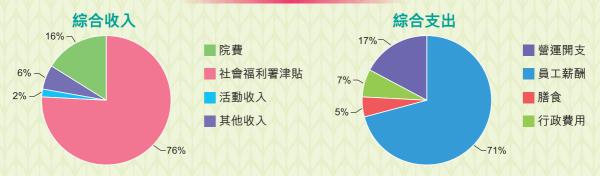
收入來源:本會過去一年,全年總收入約 \$91,610,000,較上年度 \$91,405,000 增加約 \$205,000,增幅約為 0.2%。其中主要收入來自社會福利署,全年共獲得社會福利署撥款資助約 \$69,560,000,較上年度 \$66,350,000 增加約 \$3,210,000,增幅約為 4.8%。另來自院舍和中心服務收費、各界捐款和利息等的收入,約為 \$22,230,000,較上度 \$25,160,000,減少約 \$2,930,000,減幅約為 11.6%。主要是亞洲婦女協進會頤養之家樓層進行翻新工程,為配合工程進行床位調動,令到床位房間及院費相應減少。本會除了為亞洲婦女協進會頤養之家裝修工程進行籌募捐款,也在各方面如敬老大會等活動進行籌募。伴隨著銀行定期存款利率上升,利息收入較上年度增加約 \$60,000。本年度因退休及離職,致使長期服務金及年假撥備減少而回撥約 \$394,000。

支出狀況:為回應社會福利署要求,提供多元化服務及應對日益的通貨膨脹,全年總支出約為\$93,133,000,較上年度\$93,036,000,輕微增加約\$97,000,增幅約為0.1%。各項目支出比例與往年相若,員工薪酬比重仍是最大支出,膳食開支跟隨其後。

財政儲備: 2024/25 年度儲備總數約為 \$57,710,000,包括社會福利署整筆撥款儲備約為 \$22,110,000、公積金及其他撥款儲備約為 \$15,850,000;儲備必須根據社會福利署所訂立之條款所用;而會方營運備用金額則約為 \$19,750,000。在政策上,為維持穩健財政,大部分資金已存放在本港多間大型銀行作短期存款,以備不時之需。在程序上,會方將因應收支情況、服務發展需要及長遠營運等因素,就整筆撥款儲備和公積金儲備等範疇進行會議,以徵詢意見及討論如何有效管理及善用儲備。有關的安排已刊印於年報中供會員、員工及社會人士参閱。

為增加透明度和向公眾負責,我們已將整間機構的財務報告、整筆撥款收支和機構最高三職管理 人員的薪酬表上載到社會福利署及會方網頁。有關本年度核數師報告摘要亦已刊登在本年報內。 最後本人多謝顯晉會計師事務所工作團隊悉心協助和提供寶貴專業意見,謹此致以衷心謝意。





人事委員會 2024/25年度報告

社會福利署於 2024 年 3 月及 2025 年 3 月分別發信給本會,提出有關「資源效率優化計劃」並通知未來三年本會須經歷削減資助撥款。面對撥款緊撮的大環境下,院舍及中心的各位職員均願意以積極正面的心態攜手合作,繼續提供優質服務給服務使用者,是本會莫大的福氣。同工們認為,本會於疫情期間能成功克服了種種困難,亦證明了本會團隊有良好的解難能力,勇於面對挑戰,因此深信,不論在好環境或艱難時期,各位亦能提供一貫優質服務給服務使用者,本人深信職員將繼續保持良好服務質素,為未來奠定堅實的基礎。

院舍條例有關院舍主管資歷要求

本會多名職員已於本年度成功修畢社會福利署「院舍員工培訓資助計劃」認可的「院舍主管培訓課程(甲)」課程,以達到「安老院條例」2024年12月16日起生效修訂條例中有關註冊主管資格的標準。

院舍輸入護理員特別計劃配額運用及申請

本會於 2024 年 1 月向社會福利署「院舍輸入護理員特別計劃」的申請,收到通知所有配額全數獲批。本會以此配額續聘現職已受訓現職的輸入護理員。為補充嚴重短缺之護理員人手,本會於本年度繼續申請少量輸入護理員名額,以補足部份職位。

有關向受資助單位職員發放 2024-2025 年度薪津調整

跟據社會福利署於 2024 年 7 月 15 日來函,本會津助服務單位,獲等同 2024-2025 年度公務員薪津調整,調薪幅度為增加 3%,並由 2024 年 4 月 1 日起計算,本會職級薪級表 2024 已作出相應調整。

設立員工關懷活動計劃

為提高員工對機構的歸屬感,增強職員之間溝通及團隊精神,本會設立員工關懷活動計劃。每位 半職或以上職員於本年度期間,可於非工作時間以指定金額,與單位職員共同進行團體康樂活動 或課程。各單位職員歡迎相關活動亦樂於參與團體活動,增強同事之間的溝通。

職員培訓

本會三間院舍於年度內進行多次有關腦退化症、吞嚥困難、預防感染控制、職安健工作坊及國安法等訓練。油麻地頤老中心獲香港聖約翰救護機構賽馬會「顫動人心」社區計劃資助,免費舉辦「成人心肺復蘇法及去顫法」員工培訓課程,12位職員完成課程。

發展委員會 2024/25年度報告

本會衷心感謝社會福利署獎券基金、香港賽馬會獎券基金、中電綠適樓宇基金、香港鐵路有限公司(港鐵)及各位善長的支持。本年度,本會推進多項維修工程與設備採購工作,同步開展系列宣傳及籌款活動,在提升機構品牌形象的同時,亦為自負盈虧院舍及活動中心募集營運經費。

環境優化及設備提升項目:

亞洲婦女協進會頤養之家裝修工程

在余玉荷會長、劉偉雄先生及善長的捐助支持下,本會於2024年4月起,與顧問公司多次召開工程會議並開展現場勘察,明確內部裝修細節。工程不僅更新了內部設計與裝潢,還更換多項系統,並採購新熱水爐、房間窗口式冷暖機、傢俱、餐具等設備,旨在為院舍打造現代、舒適且溫馨的居住環境。因需同步推進天台防漏工程,裝修工程工期延長,截至本年度末仍在持續推進,整體進展順利。

亞洲婦女協進會頤養之家申請「中電綠適樓宇基金」

本會向「中電綠適樓宇基金」提交申請並獲批款、資助採購房間窗口式冷暖機、飯堂天花分體式冷氣機及多部窗口式冷氣機。

何梁潔庭大樓天台防漏、避雷針更換及圍牆燈更換工程

顧問公司檢測後,發現何梁潔庭大樓天台存在多處雨水滲漏問題。本會於本年度啟動緊急維修,期間更發現天台圍牆燈嚴重生鏽破損導致雨水滲漏至下層房間,故同步更換管道並安裝新型防水圍牆燈;此外天台屋面避雷針及圍欄生鏽破損,已完成更換與加固工作,所有防水相關工程已竣工。同時,消防泵房屋面測試出有漏水問題,相關防漏維修工程亦已完成,以上三項工程於本年度內順利完工。

亞洲婦女協進會九龍塘會址地段地下管道探測工程及相關維修進度

為應對極端天氣變化,需及早改善渠道嚴重淤塞問題,本會委託渠務承辦商對地下管道開展探測。檢 測報告顯示,何梁潔庭大樓及陳昆棟大樓的地下雨水、污水管道存在多處淤塞及管內生鏽問題,需開 展高壓通渠、鑽挖式清潔及部分渠道維修改善工作,本年度已順利完成工程。

何梁潔庭頤養之家護理院院車更換

上年度,本會獲「香港賽馬會獎券基金」批款,資助更換何梁潔庭頤養之家護理院院車。本年度已完成全新 16 座歐盟六期小巴的採購與改裝,配備輪椅升降座位及安全設備,保障院友出行安全,新院車於 2025 年 2 月正式投入服務。

何梁潔庭大樓客運油壓升降機全套軟喉更換工程

年初,何梁潔庭大樓客運油壓升降機反覆出現漏油問題。經升降機保養商檢測,軟喉已使用頗長年期 而呈現老化,建議更換從地面至頂層的全套軟喉。本會通過招標方式徵集報價,已於本年度內完成軟 喉更換工程。

何梁潔庭大樓餐較更換工程

何梁潔庭大樓餐車自大樓落成後沿用至今,故障頻發需緊急維修。顧問公司提交的勘察報告建議予以更換,本年度內已通過公開招標完成前期籌備工作,計劃於下年度啟動工程。目前,該項目已向「中電綠適樓宇基金」提交申請,正等待批款。

「樂齡及康復創科應用基金」資助項目

- 亞洲婦女協進會頤養之家:2024 年 7 月獲該基金批款,採購「智關護智能防遊走及安全系統」。該系統包含防遊走人面識別、離床感應功能,可在院友出現走失或離床情況時,即時通知院舍職員,保障院友安全。
- ●油麻地頤老中心: 2024 年 7 月獲該基金批款,採購「SONIX 垂直震動訓練器全能站立儀」及 SmarTable 觸控式訓練系統,本年度內已完成設備採購並供中心會員使用。

香港中華煤氣有限公司免費更換廚房煮食爐具及多部熱水爐

本會獲香港中華煤氣有限公司免費更換廚房煮食爐具及多部熱水爐,根據合約條款,亞洲婦女協進會頤養之家及何梁潔庭頤養之家護理院需持續使用該公司煤氣服務五年。

市場推廣項目:

港鐵社區畫廊展覽

- 油麻地頤老中心:獲港鐵批准,於油麻地站社區畫廊舉辦主題為「絲絲暖意顯耆織」的作品展,展期 為 2024 年 5 月 1 日至 5 月 30 日。
- 陳昆棟頤養之家護理安老院:獲港鐵批准,於九龍塘站社區畫廊舉辦主題為「繁花似錦」的作品展, 展期為 2024 年 6 月 1 日至 6 月 30 日。

港鐵扶手電梯廣告宣傳

本會獲港鐵批准,於各站扶手電梯投放 400 張機構宣傳海報,展期為 2024 年 10 月 2 日至 10 月 17 日,本次宣傳活動已順利完成。

永旺(香港)百貨有限公司(AEON)「幸福的黃色小票」公益活動

本會向永旺(香港)百貨有限公司(AEON)申請參與第二十六屆「幸福的黃色小票」公益活動並獲批。 活動期為 2025 年 2 月 11 日至 2025 年 7 月,感謝該公司提供場地支持本會開展宣傳與籌款工作。

亞洲婦女協進會「讓光照亮‧以愛傳承」籌募計劃

本計劃以「光」為設計核心 — 「光」既象徵明亮與溫暖,也代表「以院舍為家」的精神內核,旨在讓長者感受溫暖與關愛。計劃主要為亞洲婦女協進會頤養之家及何梁潔庭自負盈虧活動中心募集經費,目前已啟動籌款工作。

亞洲婦女協進會標語創作大賽

為加強與公眾、服務使用者及家屬的互動,本會舉辦以「連繫家庭」為主題的標語創作大賽,徵集契合亞洲婦女協進會服務形象的作品。大賽共收到 109 份參賽作品,已於 2025 年度敬老大會為獲獎者頒發紀念品,部分獲獎標語已應用於本會宣傳品。

亞洲婦女協進會九龍塘會址正門及後門宣傳橫額、後門玻璃門貼設計更新

為加強對本區居民的機構品牌宣傳,本會更新了正門及後門外牆宣傳橫額及後門玻璃門貼,強化對外宣傳效果,提升機構整體形象展示。

亞洲婦女協進會網站優化

本會已啟動優化網站內容工作,計劃新增行政架構、招標通告、籌款、義工招募等板塊,網站優化後將於下年度正式上線。

亞洲婦女協進會頤養之家 360° VR 虛擬實景導覽圖像製作

為加大自負盈虧院舍的推廣力度,本會計劃為亞洲婦女協進會頤養之家製作 3D 虛擬實景導覽圖像,幫助公眾直觀了解院舍內部環境。待頤養之家裝修工程完成後,把導覽圖像上傳至本會網站及社交媒體平台。

院舍服務

陳昆棟頤養之家護理安老院

陳昆棟頤養之家於 1987 年 12 月成立,是亞洲婦女協進會第一所為社會福利署津助的頤養之家院舍,共有 150 個宿位,包括 40 個療養宿位及 110 個護理宿位,為體弱而缺乏自我照顧能力的長者提供持續性照顧服 務。

本院亦設有日間護理中心、緊急宿位及暫住宿位,有需要的長者可以透過所住區域的社會福利署或非政府機構轄下的綜合家庭服務中心、醫務社會工作者、長者地區中心、長者鄰舍中心、長者活動中心或綜合家居照顧服務隊的社工轉介入住。

在院友生活照顧方面,本院透過社工、醫護人員、物理治療師、職業治療師、言語治療師、營養師等專業團隊,以跨專業的工作模式提供適切護理照顧,健康評估及均衡膳食安排,讓院友在院舍內安享晚年。在社交心理照顧上亦為院友提供心理輔導、社交小組和舒展身心的娛樂活動,讓他們安享富尊嚴及愉快的生活,達至圓滿人生。

在心理及社交服務方面,本年度服務計劃以「家舍同行樂滿 FUN」為年度主題,透過鼓勵院友繼續維持做運動,強身健體。讓他們可以參加不同班組,培養、發展興趣及潛能,接觸新事物,以正面樂觀的心態發展個人興趣,達至終生學習,為生活加添姿彩。另外,本院更著重家舍合作,鼓勵親友陪伴院友參與活動及成為義工,藉此以提升院友及親友對院舍的歸屬感及參與度,以院舍為家。

何梁潔庭頤養之家護理院

何梁潔庭頤養之家護理院於 1998 年 8 月成立,是社會福利署津助的院舍,共有 120 名宿位,包括 81 名女性宿位,39 名男性宿位,照顧對象為體弱而缺乏自我照顧能力而精神上適合群體生活的長者。

本院提供膳宿、起居照顧、個人護理、醫療、康復、輔導及各類康樂活動等服務。院舍定期舉辦治療運動及社交康樂活動,同時照顧院友身心所需,令他們能得到全面優質之關顧服務,安享頤養天年。

在護理及起居照顧方面,本年度定期釐定及檢討院友個人照顧計劃,根據院友健康狀況提供醫生到診服務及老人科外展服務,亦按院友需要進行言語治療服務、足病診療及採耳服務。此外,為加強預防季節性流感,為院友接種流感疫苗及 XBB 新冠疫苗,提升防護能力。為了提升服務質素,根據院友的健康狀況及護理需求,將適時更換及添置部分醫療器材、電器及家具。

在復康服務方面,本院提供物理治療服務,為院友進行評估,制定合適的治療計劃,設計健體運動,培養院友定時運動的習慣及興趣,以維持身體機能或減慢退化,預防因缺乏運動導致的併發症,達到保健及防跌的效果。此外,職業治療師為有認知障礙症的院友安排小組或個別治療,協助減緩腦退化,並提供復康器材,以減低他們生活上的障礙及維持活動能力。

在心理及社交服務方面,本院提供院舍生活服務及充權活動,定期與院友之親友保持聯絡。院舍也提供多元化的康樂及社交活動,並提供義工工作機會,與不同社區義工及義工團體合作,如佛教慧賢行、佛教法音傳播中心、天主教聖德勒撒堂、及大愛無限新力量等。

未來一年,我們將以「家舍同行樂滿 FUN」及「支援有愛 自立無礙」為主題。在「家舍同行樂滿 FUN」方面,院舍將繼續鼓勵家人參與活動並成為義工,加強與院舍的溝通與合作,提升家人對院 舍的信任與參與度。而在「支援有愛 自立無礙」的主題上,院舍會鼓勵院友發揮個人興趣,從而提升生活質素,實現快樂晚年。

油麻地頤老中心成立於 1976 年,為油尖旺區的長者們提供社交和康樂活動。社會福利署於 2003 年度重整長者社區支援服務,中心提升為長者鄰舍中心,繼續給予油尖旺區的長者們更全面的綜合社區支援服務,以滿足長者身體、心理、社交、精神和個人護理方面的需求。

REPORT OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

Business review

The objective of the League

The objective of the League is to implement, execute and participate in the welfare and charitable activities of the elders, women and children. The League actively promotes the spirit of "Respect, Love and Care for the Elderly" by providing different kinds of services for the Elderly to improve their quality of life.

Business Background

- 1. There are five social services operating units at our League, namely:
 - i. the Chan Kwun Tung Care and Attention Home for the Elderly ("CKT Home");
 - ii. the Ho Leung Kit Ting Care and Attention Home for the Elderly ("HLKT Home");
 - iii. the Yau Ma Tei Neighbourhood Elderly Centre ("YMT Centre");
 - iv. the Self-financing Home for the Elderly ("SF Home"); and
 - v. the Ho Leung Kit Ting Self-financing Activity Centre ("HLKT Centre")

Industries background

According to the Social Welfare Department ("SWD") public data as of 30th June 2025, we have 2
out of 181 homes under the type of "subvented homes, self-financing homes and contract homes"
that provide subsidised residential services and 1 out of 98 homes with non-subsidised places for
elderly.

Special resource

- To fulfil the concern of the public and service users, the SWD has specifically designed for our Executive Committee members and senior management courses and symposiums on various management aspects towards better practices and improving corporate governance and accountability.
- 4. In particular, we aim to keep abreast of proper governance to help the League in developing a sustainable and stable direction. We took the opportunity to join as a member of The Hong Kong Council of Social Service ("HKCSS") in a Governance Platform Project to strengthen the flow of the board and to learn to enhance the potential of development of the League.

The objective of the operation

- To improve and upgrade the facilities of the service units, the League has applied for different charity funds from both governmental and non-governmental organisations for facilities replacement.
- 6. In order to maintain a positive reserve for the Self-financing Home, the Executive Committee has continuously reviewed and adjusted the operating flow and policy of broadening sources of income and reducing expenditure.

External environment

7. In the post-pandemic environment, all five social services units are operating as usual, including normal visiting arrangement, numerous activities and programme launched, continuous development and maintenance on the facilities etc. The League is glad to embrace the full recovery of Hong Kong with the whole society.

However, The Hong Kong Government announced that Productivity Enhancement Programme will be implemented under which recurrent government expenditure will be cut by 2% for 2025/26, by 5% for 2026/27 and by 7% for 2027/28. In the coming years, the League will suffer from reduction of subventions and therefore must maintain prudent financial management to response the policy.

REPORT OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

Business review (continued)

Income

 In the year 2024/25, overall income (HK\$91.61 million) was slightly increased by 0.22% as compared with 2023/24 (HK\$91.40 million). The difference reflects the contrary movements on the FSA and Non-FSA income. For detail figures please refer to the full version of Committees' Report.

Expenditure

 In the year 2024/25, overall expenditure (HK\$93.13 million) was slightly increased by 0.1% as compared with 2023/24 (HK\$93.04 million). The difference reflects the contrary movements on the FSA and Non-FSA expenditure. For detail figures please refer to the full version of Committees' Report.

Surplus / Deficit for the year

10. In the year of 2024/25, overall net result (-HK\$1.52 million) has decreased by 6.66% as compared with 2023/24 net deficit (-HK\$1.63 million). These adverse results are mainly due to increase in staff costs and reduction of accommodation income. For detailed figures please refer to the full version of Committees' Report.

The Respond to the Deficit for the year

11. SF Home is a significant party in Non-FSA operation and its main source of income is accommodation fee. In order to upgrade the entire environment of the residential home, renovation work has been carried out during the year. In the first phase of renovation, residents were gathered and moved into a floor with multi-beds rooms at SF Home. Less dues and fees were charged for that room than single bed or twin beds room. During 2024/25, the accommodation income was decreased by 20.72% as compared with last year.

To respond on the situation of SF Home, the Executive Committee keeps monitoring on the progress of the renovation and seeks for re-opening of the home. Dues and fees may be recovered afterwards to the level that before the renovation. Moreover, more promotions on the services of two self-financing units will be placed.

Financial Position

- 12. In the year of 2024/25, the League has new additions of fixed assets in the sum of HK\$10,632,710 while in 2023/24, the new additions were amounted to HK\$536,145.
- 13. By the end of 2024/25, our net current assets (HK\$57.85 million) have decreased by 5.29% as compared with the end of 2023/24 (HK\$61.08 million). The drop of assets are mainly from withdrawal from bank and increase in the provision for short-term employee benefits.
- 14. The League has maintained a money deposit in the sum of HK\$60.18 million as at the end of 2024/25 at various banks of high credit rating. It was decreased by 5.71% as compared to HK\$63.83 million by the end of 2023/24. The money deposit with the bank is composed of time deposit and cash deposit.
- 15. The League's current ratio was 1327.70% by the end of 2024/25, which has decreased by 19.32% as compared with 1645.66% by the end of 2023/24. The ratio reflects that the liquidity performance is worse than last year's performance but the League's performance is still maintained at a positive position.

REPORT OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

Business review (continued)

Funds and Reserves

- 16. The League is a service operator bound by the FSA. Thus, all funds received under FSA can only be spent on expenditures within the terms of FSA. According to the FSA, if the net subvention amount exceeds 25% of the unit's operating expenditure, SWD would claw-back the grant of the excess. However, SWD reserves the right not to claw-back until 2025/26 under Productivity Enhancement Programme.
- 17. As mentioned in above paragraph 10, the League's Non-FSA deficit has turned downward in this year. At the end of 2024/25, the aggregate balance of Accumulated Fund under Non-FSA decreased by 8.69% from last year. To deal with this issue, the Executive Committee was taking actions for improvement as mentioned in paragraph 11.
- 18. The League seeks for different funds from various parties to support our operation and to achieve our objective. For details of the function of each fund, please refer to the financial statement disclosed in note 16 to 18. With respect to the Other Fund, the aggregate balance amounts to HK\$13,291,000 in 2025 as compared to HK\$5,780,002 in 2024 in financing the League's operations.

Continuous improvement of service quality

- 19. During 2024/25, three care homes received 130 appreciations and 1 complaint. We welcome and encourage various parties to reflect their views and to help us improve our service continuously.
- 20. A total of 3,662 activities were held by the three cares homes with 96,620 overall attendances.
- 21. Throughout the year, we have maintained a staff team of 178 serving 282 elderlies (the ratio of staff establishment is 1 staff: 1.58 elderly) in our residential homes. In our adjacent service centers, we have 1,232 members in 2024/25 compared with 1,088 members in 2023/24.
- 22. Yaumatei Neighbourhood Elderly Centre served over 1,130 members during the year by organizing a total of 361 interest classes, groups, programmes and seminars and 166 of them were jointly organized with our strategic partners in the community.
 - Moreover, the YMT Centre is a recognized service provider under the Scheme on Living Allowance for Carers of Elderly Persons from Low-income Families and has provided counselling and support services to its elderly members, hidden or vulnerable elderly persons and needy carers.
 - In response to the latest update of FSA on Neighbourhood Elderly Centre, members with age 55 to 59 are welcome since October 2023. Both numbers of Young-old members and Old-old members meet the requirements of SWD.
- 23. Ho Leung Kit Ting Self-financing Activity Centre served over 90 members during the year by organizing a total of 120 classes, such as Tai Chi, Singing, Calligraphy etc.

League's Policies and compliance with the relevant laws and regulations

- 24. The League strictly follows the Social Welfare Department's Best Practice Manual guidelines on human resource management, financial management, as well as corporate governance and accountability, which are recommended by the Lump Sum Grant Independent Review Committee.
- 25. As a matter of prudence, we continue to make use of limited resources to achieve fiscal balance and maximize resource usage. Details of the policy carried out during the financial year are stated in paragraph 33 to 37 and 46 to 54.
- 26. Financial reports are prepared in accordance with all relevant legal requirements of Social Welfare Department Lump Sum Grant Manual Guideline, Best Practice Manual and Hong Kong Companies Ordinance. In response to public accountability, we update and disclose in our website about our Lump Sum Grant Annual Financial Reports, Review Reports on Staff Remuneration Packages as well as our organization chart.

REPORT OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

Business review (continued)

League's Policies and compliance with the relevant laws and regulations (Continued)

- 27. The League has been enjoying the tax exemption status awarded to charitable organisations in accordance with the Inland Revenue Ordinance, and has been allowed to issue tax-exemption receipts. In addition, the donation funding would be deposited into separate bank accounts for verification.
- 28. In response to timely and sustainable development, the management structure was maintained and followed with the latest requirements of SWD. The Committee has reviewed and updated the organization chart and has disclosed the top-3-level of management publicly.
- 29. The Residential Care Homes Legislation (Miscellaneous Amendments) Ordinance 2024 (the Amendment Ordinance) is effective since 2023. The League strictly follows the Amendment Ordinance, such as strengthening the accountability of RCH operators; enhancing the minimum staffing requirements etc.
- 30. The Hong Kong Government announced that Productivity Enhancement Programme will be implemented under which recurrent government expenditure will be cut by 2% for 2025/26, by 5% for 2026/27 and by 7% for 2027/28. For the coming year of 2025/26, the SWD subventions are expected to reduce by about HK\$1,300,000. In response to Government policy, the League would maintain prudent financial management and implement policy of broadening sources of income and reducing expenditure.
- 31. From 2023/24 and afterwards, Central administration charges back administrative service fee from SF Home and HLKT Centre which represents internal management fee and is determined in accordance with time cost consumed by corresponding staff on administrative work, such as accounting & internal control, human resources services, etc. It is used to compensate the resources used by the Central Administration under the Lump Sum Grant.
- 32. The League and its service units have reviewed and updated their Service Quality Standards (SQSs) with SWD during the year which aim to provide quality social welfare services and strengthen the accountability of welfare services.

Human resources and employee development

- 33. A total of 39 training sessions were held this year and 945 members participated. Training topics include, basic safety training for staff, knowledge of The National Security Law, inflection control, elder abuse and Dementia etc. The above training courses aimed to strengthen the staff members' skills to meet different needs of service users and stakeholders.
- 34. The League has issued different employment policies and provided sustainable benefits to encourage employees and raise up their loyalty to our League. In this year, we have newly provided subsidy for social activities held by a group of 8 staff outside working hours. Furthermore, we have regularly reviewed the remuneration package of all staff and adjusted them if applicable.
- 35. The last Chief Executive Officer ("CEO") was retired since June 2022, the position is still vacant as of the date of this report. As per the top-3-level of management structure, the Deputy CEO (Central Control & Community Care) and Deputy CEO (Residential Service) are the key management personnel in the operation of the League currently.
- 36. The League had applied Supplementary Labour Scheme in these years. There are 22 foreign labour who remains in the workspace and have satisfying performance. The League has renewed their contracts during the year with raised salary of 8% and hardship allowance introduced. Also, the Executive Committee approved to apply further import care workers for the workforce of three Homes
- 37. The League has used different solutions to relieve the lack of manpower and maintain the quality of service, such as offer favorable remuneration package, outsource some services, simplify body check requirements etc.

REPORT OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

Business review (continued)

Key Activities and Related Grants

- 38. In order to replace the motor vehicle at HLKT Home which has been in use for 13 years, the SWD granted a sum of \$1,019,656 under Lotteries Fund. The new motor vehicle has been used since February 2025. Also, the League has applied a funding from Lotteries Fund for replacement of dumbwaiter and a lift in HLKT Home and is waiting for reply from the SWD.
- 39. For monetary donations, the League is thankful for the donations of \$4,000,000 received from Ms. YU Yuk Ho who is a member of the Executive Committee and \$2,500,000 from Mr. LAU Wai Hung during the year. The donations will be used in the renovation work of SF Home. Besides, the League is glad to receive donations from numerous donors to support assets acquisition during renovation
- 40. YMT Centre had been granted a funding from The Hong Kong Jockey Club Charities Trust ("JC") of \$780,000 in last year to promote preventive healthcare among the elderly and empower them in health management. The project is extended till 30th September 2025 with further subsidies of \$71,000.
 - Furthermore, in the support of JC, YMT Centre had been granted a sum of \$306,000 to support elders through digital tablets and online programmes.
- 41. In this year, the League received fundings from the Innovation and Technology Fund, at a sum of HK\$777,672, to acquire body trainer devices, Drugs management system etc.
- 42. The League is grateful for the support and donations from people across all communities which include food, entertainment and other materials. We have distributed all of them to our members and elderlies who are in need.
- 43. The League's key grants came from the SWD subvention. In the total sum of over HK\$69.57 million, the SWD subvention received by the League amounts to 75,94% of the total revenue for 2024/25. Compared to the subvention received in 2023/24 (i.e. HK\$66.35 million), the subvention has increased by HK\$3.22 million (equivalent to 4.85%) in 2024/25.
- 44. One of the most important events of the League, 53 週年紀念暨敬老大會, has been held on 3rd January 2025. About \$487,000 was received from donors in the event.

Environmental and Development

45. In order to satisfy the needs of residents and to ensure the quality of services provided to elderly members, the League has a number of environmental improvement projects to be completed, and has acquired some equipment for residents' use.

Rooms and bathrooms repair and renovation at CKT and HLKT Home

46. There were paint peeling and water leakage on several rooms and bathrooms at CKT Home and HLKT Home. In order to provide a comfortable environment, the Executive Committee has arranged contractors to renovate the rooms. Fees for such repairment work have been granted by the Lump Sum Grant issued by the SWD and its Lotteries Fund. The works were completed during the financial year.

Public areas repair and renovation at CKT Home

47. There were several places with serious concrete peeling, such as rooftop, generator room, laundry room etc. In order to strengthen the safety of the environment, renovation for CKT was carried out. The contruction work is granted by Lump Sum Grant issued by SWD.

Business review (continued)

Environmental and Development (Continued)

Rooftop repair and renovation at HLKT Home

48. There was water leakage on the rooftop of the HLKT Building. To ensure a safe environment provided to our residents, repair work was arranged to provide a waterproof coating on the Rooftop. The fee was paid and apportioned between SF Home, HLKT Centre and HLKT Home.

Renovation work at SF Home

49. SF Home did not have major renovation since its opening. Rooms and washrooms are damaged and stale. To order to improve the environment, the Executive Committee has conducted renovation on the whole residential home. The work was started in July 2024. As of the date of this report, renovation on a floor of the SF Home is completed while another floor is still in progress.

Replacement of stove on kitchen at HLKT Home

50. The stove on the kitchen at HLKT Home have been in use since 2015 and are impaired. With the subsidies from Towngas amounted at HK\$250,700, replacement on impaired stove is taken place.

Replacement of Fire resisting doors at CKT Home

51. The Fire resisting doors at CKT Home have been in use since its commissioning. Some of the doors were damaged and not repairable. To prevent injuries and deaths, the Executive Committee decided to replace these doors. Fees for conducting such replacement work have been granted by the Lump Sum Grant issued by the SWD.

Additions and replacement of Television at CKT and SF Home

 To provide a better leisure environment to residents, over 18 televisions were replaced and newly acquired in the canteen and rooms.

Filters of Air purifiers

53. Upon the post-pandemic period, the filters were periodically replaced to ensure the effectiveness of the air purifiers and the quality of air within the League. A sum of 80 filters were replaced in the CKT Home and HLKT Home.

Replacement of motor vehicle at HLKT Home

 Lotteries Fund has granted a fund to replace a new motor vehicle which is available to use since February 2025.

Unless otherwise stated hereinabove, there are no important events that have occurred since the end of the financial year affecting the League's future performance and financial position.

Equity-Linked Agreements

No equity-linked agreements were entered into by the League during the financial year or subsisted at the end of the financial year.

Executive Committee's Interests

Apart from the foregoing, no other contract of significance to which the League was a party and in which the Executive Committee had a material interest or subsisted at the end of the year or at any time during the year.

At no time during the year was the League a party to any arrangements to enable the Executive Committee to acquire benefits by means of acquisition of debentures, if any, of the League or any other body corporate.

Donation

During the financial year, no donation for charitable or other purposes was made by the League (2024: Nil).

Auditors

The combined financial statements for the year have been audited by A.C Fortune CPA Company Limited who retire and, being eligible, offer themselves for re-appointment. A resolution for re-appointment of A.C Fortune CPA Company Limited as auditors of the Company is to be proposed at the forthcoming annual general meeting.

GENERAL INFORMATION

(a) Corporate information

The League is a Company incorporated in Hong Kong under Predecessor Companies Ordinance with limited liability by guarantee. At the date of issue of these summary combined financial statements, the registered office of the League is located at 4th Floor, Henry G. Leong Yaumatei Community Centre, 60 Public Square Street, Yaumatei, Kowloon. The League's principal activities are providing residential services to the elderly and programme activities to the members. It has been operating five social service units for the elderly, namely,

- Chan Kwun Tung Care and Attention Home for the Elderly
- Ho Leung Kit Ting Care and Attention Home for the Elderly
- Ho Leung Kit Ting Self-financing Activity Centre
- Yau Ma Tei Neighbourhood Elderly Centre
- Self-financing Home for the Elderly

These summary combined financial statements, as approved by the Executive Committee, have been derived from the audited combined financial statements of the League for the year ended 31st March 2025 and contain the combined statements of financial position, combined statement of profit or loss and other comprehensive income, combined statement of changes and funds and reserves and combined statement of cash flows as presented therein.

In addition, these summary combined financial statements contain notes, as derived from the audited combined financial statements, in relation to significant revenue and income generated from and expenses incurred for the principal activities of the League. Therefore, these summary combined financial statements do not contain sufficient information to allow a full understanding of the combined results.
